membered joy.

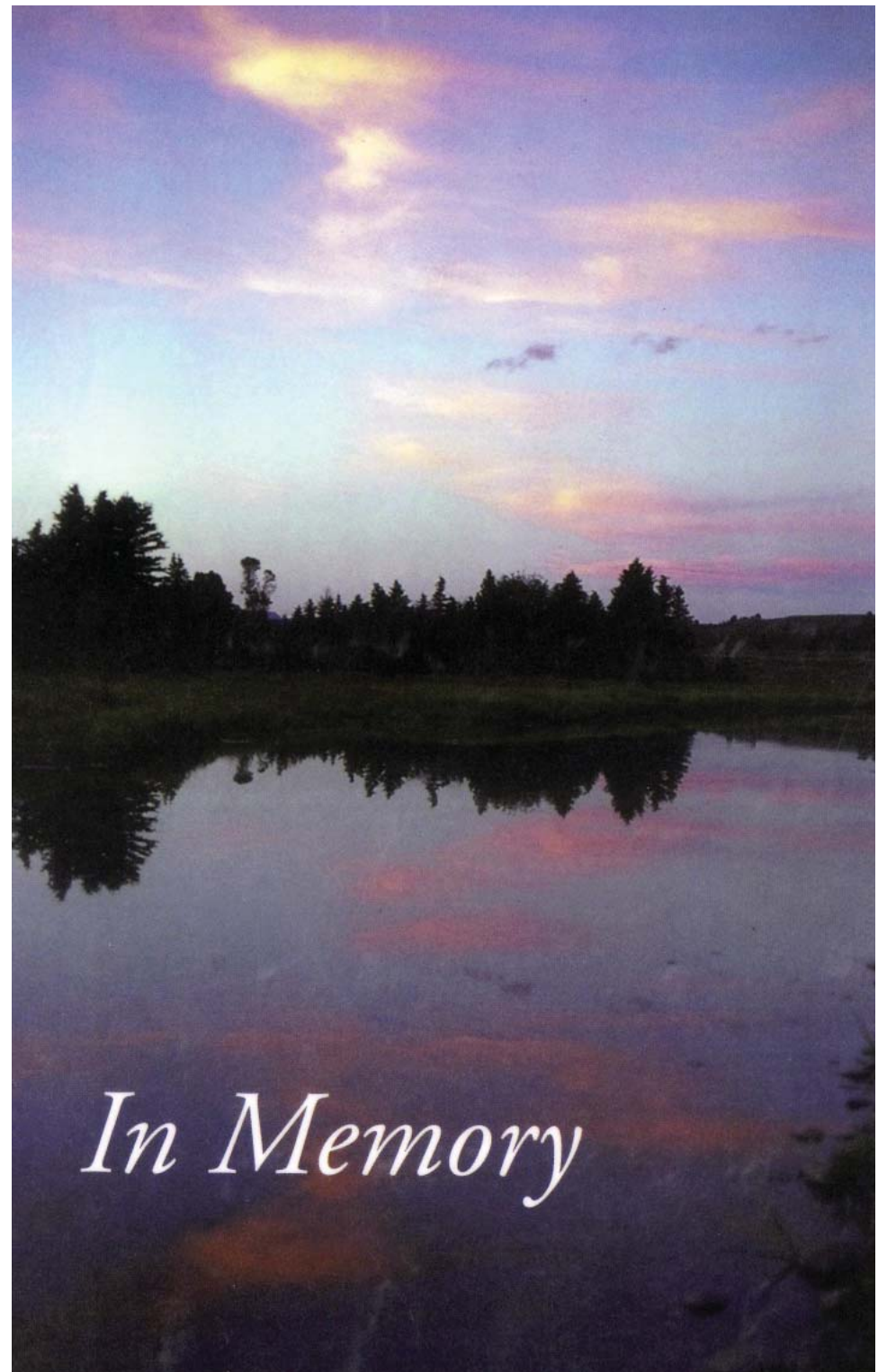
A friendship shared, a laugh, a kiss, ah, yes, these
