Larry Charles Hauge was born August 19, 1938, in Ottertail County, Minnesota to Harold and Myrtle (Weiss) Hauge. He was baptized and confirmed in Fergus Falls. Larry attended school in Fergus Falls and was lifelong resident of Fergus Falls.

On August 19, 1960, he was united in marriage to Mavis Elshaug at Trinity Lutheran Church in Fergus Falls by Pastor Knick. Larry worked for the City of Fergus Falls for 35 years.
